COVID-19 Update



For Family and Friends of Ottewell Manor lodge residents

Over the last two years many of you have not been able to spend quality time with your loved one because of the various pandemic related restrictions issued by the Chief Medical Officer of Health, the Government of Alberta or the City of Edmonton. We wanted to express our thanks to you for your cooperation, patience and support over this time as we implemented and followed the many mandated restrictions. As you know the Government of Alberta announced the lifting of restrictions for some GEF lodges effective June 30, 2022 however, there are restrictions that will still apply to Ottewell Manor.

What this means:

- Screening will no longer be required for visitors. However, we would encourage you to not visit the lodge if you are not feeling well.
- Residents who are symptomatic will be required to isolate until they are tested by Alberta Health Services and return a negative result.

What measures will continue:

- Staff and visitors are still required to wear a mask at Ottewell Manor.

While the pandemic continues and the COVID-19 virus remains present in the community, we will continue to work with everyone to keep you, our residents and our staff safe and healthy.
